Eligibility

Alliance members, their children and grandchildren are eligible. Each applicant must be a high school senior planning to be a full-time college student, or a full-time college student during the 2023/2024 school year. To ensure fairness in the judging, Alliance employees, officials and their immediate family members are not eligible, nor are past Alliance scholarship recipients.

Scholarships to be Awarded

Alliance will award three \$5,000 scholarships this year. Scholarship funds will be paid to the university in the student's name.

Selection and Presentation

Judging will be completed by a panel consisting of employees and will be based solely on a review of the application information. There is no grade point average or college test score to qualify. Winners will be notified in March.

How to Apply

- 1. Complete the Application
- 2. Choose to do either a written or video essay on the following topic: If you had the authority to change your community in a positive way, what specific changes would you make and what steps would you take to make them?

Selected essays may be used by Alliance Credit Union for internal or external publication.

- 3. Write why you need the scholarship: Describe any personal or family circumstances affecting your need for financial assistance. If you do not need financial assistance, please tell us why you are a good candidate. This part of the application can be completed by video if you choose. No preference will be given to either format.
